

# 1-Day 4GG Tournament Rules

**Our Tournaments are intended to be for the enjoyment and development of the players.**

**Players and their parents take their lead from the team’s coaches.**

**You are their role model.**

**We require all team rosters to be loaded onto the USA Softball website at [NortheastFP.com](http://NortheastFP.com). All full-time and guest players participating in an event must be on your roster by the time of your first game of an event. If a player is challenged and does not appear on your roster, she will be removed from the event and your team may forfeit the game.**

**This tournament is sanctioned by USA Softball and governed by its rules with the only exceptions in this document. Regardless of this, the umpire’s decision is *FINAL*.**

- There will be no pre-game warm-up allowed on infields. Pitchers may use foul territories to warm up.
- All players must be eligible for the age group they are playing in, per the USA Softball Age Rule chart

## **Tournament Format (all ages):**

- Pool play games are 1hr 10min, finish the batter. The score DOES NOT revert and ties are allowed.
- Consolation games are 1hr 15min, finish the inning. No ITB will be used and ties are allowed.
- Semifinal and Championship games are 1hr 15min, finish the inning. ITB will be used in the inning following time limit expiration; ties are not allowed.
  - Bracket seeding tie-breakers are:
    - Record
    - Head to head record
    - Runs given up
    - Runs Scored
    - Coin flip

- At Home Run Tournaments we like to stay on schedule. All games may begin up to 15 minutes early if both coaches agree and the Umpire is ready. The Tournament Directors may start games early to correct the schedule from a late start or when weather may become an issue.

**Game Format (all ages except where noted):**

- Mercy rules apply for all games - 12 runs after 4 innings, 10 runs after 5 innings.
- Further traveling team calls the coin toss for Home/Away.
- Base runners may take a lead once the pitcher **releases** the ball.
- 10U & 12U Only: No “Butcher Boy” hitting. Fake bunting and swinging away is NOT allowed. If this occurs, a dead ball will be called. The batter is out, and runner(s) return to their original bases.
- 08U only:
  - Games are 6 innings. 5 Run limit per inning. Unlimited runs in 6th inning.
  - Teams must roster bat.
  - Infield Hit - Base runners are limited to one base on all batted balls hit in the infield. No advances are allowed for overthrows to any base.
  - On an outfield hit (any ground or fly ball hit at least 10 feet beyond an infielder or any ball that is fielded by an outfielder), base runners may take additional bases. The play stops when the ball is secured by an infielder on the dirt. Runners who have not attained the halfway point between bases when the play stops will be sent back to the prior base by the umpire.
  - No bases can be stolen. Base runners may take a lead once the ball crosses the plate.
  - Pitching distance will be 35 feet and will use 11 inch balls.
- 10U only:
  - Games are 6 innings. 5 run limit per inning, unlimited runs innings 4-6.
  - Teams may play 3 or 4 outfielders in the field.
  - Teams may roster bat but do not have to. If a team decides to bat only 10 players all remaining players will be treated as subs.
  - Pitching distance will be 35 feet and will use 11 inch balls.
  - No dropped third strike, no infield fly
  - Slapping is allowed, but batters cannot square to bunt, pull-back and swing
  - Continuation walks are not allowed
  - B/C events: Stealing of 2nd and 3rd base only. Runner is allowed 1 stolen base per pitch, and cannot advance on an overthrow to any base.
  - Open events: Stealing of 2nd, 3rd and home is allowed. Runner is allowed 1 stolen base per pitch, and cannot advance on an overthrow to any base.
- 12U only:
  - Games are 7 innings. No run limit per inning.
  - 3 outfielders play the field
  - Teams can bat in any of the formats allowable by USA Softball.
  - Any base can be stolen and continuation is allowed on walks. Dropped third strike, infield fly and look back rules are in effect.
  - Pitching distance will be 40 feet and will use 12 inch balls.
- 14U/16U/18U only:

- Games are 7 innings. No run limit per inning.
- Teams can bat in any of the formats allowable by USA Softball.
- In an attempt to get in full games, a continuing pitcher will receive 4 warm ups the first inning, 3 every inning thereafter. A new pitcher will receive 4 warm ups.
- There is no limit to how many times a pitcher may be put in per game.
- Only one trip to the mound is allowed per inning per pitcher, all subsequent trips in the inning must be to remove the pitcher from pitching.
- Stalling will not be permitted as determined by the umpire – if so determined; the umpire may override the time limit if a team is determined to be intentionally stalling.

### Courtesy Runners

- Courtesy runners are allowed for pitchers and catchers at any time.
- The courtesy runner is a substitute not in the game (if not batting entire line-up), or the last batted out (if batting entire line-up). Or an injured player that has been identified and agreed to by both coaches and umpires prior to the start of the game
- The pitcher and catcher are identified as the last players who physically played that position.

### Weather

- Inclement Weather – in the event of inclement weather it may be necessary to play shortened games or to adopt an alternate format for the tournament. We reserve the right to change the tournament format as needed.
- We reserve the right to adjust the rules, schedules, brackets, and field locations, if necessary, in order to complete the tournament. Every attempt will be made to honor the game minimum – however, if a situation develops where a team forfeits or the weather does not cooperate, every attempt possible will be made to reschedule, shorten or cancel games in order to complete the tournament.
- Rain and cancellation policies can be found on our website

### Score Reporting

- Winning coach should text the game score to the group chat immediately following the game
- The Tournament Directors have the final say on all disputes.

### Other Information

- Umpire decisions are final. No protests allowed. Video replay does not exist.
- Game time is forfeit time – to be enforced by the Umpire and/or at the Tournament Director's discretion. In rain situations, please do not leave the fields as the schedule may be adjusted without prior notice.
- Please do not impede the progress of the game. Any signs of poor sportsmanship, actions that demean opposing players, fans, or the umpire may be grounds for the offender(s) to be removed permanently from the game and premises. And if serious, the possibility of their team forfeiting the game. **Any coach/player ejected from a ball game by an official, will also be suspended from the team's next game (at minimum) – with further penalty if warranted.**
- Alcohol is forbidden at ALL complexes. There is no smoking allowed inside any park. Walk to the



roadway or parking areas.

- Teams are responsible for cleaning out their dugout! PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE ANYTHING BEHIND and put all trash in the proper containers or bag. WE WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR LOST OR STOLEN PROPERTY! **Please have the girls, coaches and parents clean up after themselves.**
