



2025 Woodbury Wildpitch



Welcome to the 2025 Woodbury Wild Pitch tournament! Pool play games are posted for Friday night and Saturday games on MN Softball. Pool games will determine the single elimination tournament on Sunday.

Tournament Rules and conditions:

Teams must check in the wheel at Ojibway at least 30 minutes prior to the start of their 1st scheduled game, and be prepared to turn in 2 game balls. Make sure your roster is 100% completed inside of MN softball as it will be checked before the tournament begins.

We are anticipating the main parking lot to fill up. There is overflow parking available by the High School. Parking will not be allowed on the road beside Field #1. Parking signs will be placed where not allowed.

General:

- The tournament is MN Softball sanctioned.
- Umpire decisions are final! No appeals will be allowed to the Tournament Director.
- The Tournament Director reserves the right to shorten or cancel games in the event of bad weather or other tournament delay.
 - In the event of inclement weather, the tournament director reserves the right to adjust the number of games, game length, and schedule to meet conditions. Rain Policy: in the event the tournament becomes unplayable (no games played) teams will be reimbursed all but \$25 of registration and administrative fees. If teams play 1 game, there will be a 50% reimbursement. If at least 2 games are completed, no reimbursement will be issued.
- The Tournament Director reserves the right to modify any of these rules and/or conditions as necessary to ensure the success of the tournament and the safety of its participants and spectators.
- Heckling of the umpires or opposing teams will not be allowed. The coach of the team whose fans violate this rule will be warned once. If the heckling continues, fans will be asked to leave the premises. Fans not complying within two minutes will cause the forfeiture of the game to the opposing team. Coaches, please discuss this with your fans prior to coming to the tournament to avoid any misunderstandings.
- No outside food is allowed within the perimeter of the circle of fields. Concessions and food trucks will be available.
- Smoking is not allowed as it is on school grounds.
- Pets are allowed as long as they are not disruptive and owners pick up after them. • For any security concerns, please go to the concession stand and ask to speak with a member of the tournament committee.
- There are no restrictions on the number of innings a pitcher can pitch. • For safety purposes, on-deck batters must warm up behind the batter, regardless of their team's dugout.
- All teams must bat their roster throughout the tournament.
- There is unlimited substitution of players on defense.
- Courtesy runners may be used for pitchers and catchers of record.

8u/10u/12u divisions - Pool Play (Friday night & Saturday) (8U is Saturday only)

- 10u/12u divisions will each have 2 or 3 pools and play on Friday night and throughout Saturday. **8u will have 3 pool play games Saturday and medals for 1st and 2nd place.**
 - Sunday is a single elimination tournament tiered out with Gold, Silver, and Bronze (if applicable) Brackets.
- Results of the pool play games will determine your teams placement in Sunday's single elimination tournament play.
- All games will have one umpire.
- A team not ready to play within 15 minutes of the scheduled start time of their game will forfeit that game. The exception being a team that is finishing up a previous game. • A coin toss at the beginning of each game will determine the home team during Bracket Pool Play.
- The following run rules will apply:
 - 15 after 3 / 12 after 4 / 8 after 5.
 - Teams in the 10U Divisions may score a maximum of 5 runs per half inning, including championship games.
- Friday night and Saturday games are 65 minutes, or 7 innings, or run-rule end, whichever comes first. No new inning may start after 65 minutes; innings in progress at the 65 minute mark will be completed.
- **Tie Breaker rules** in Pool Play: If the game is tied after time has expired, there will be extra innings. Each extra inning will start with the following:
 - Inning 1 will start with the last batter out the previous inning on 2nd base and 1 out.
 - Inning 2 will start with the last batter out the previous inning on 2nd base with 2 outs
 - If after 2 innings, the game is still tied the following, in order, will be considered for the tie breaker.
 - Higher number of outs recorded on defense during the extra innings.
 - Higher number of outs recorded during regular inning play.
 - Coin Flip

10u/12u divisions - Single Elimination Tournament (Sunday)

- Sunday is a single elimination tournament tiered out with Gold, Silver, and Bronze Brackets.
- All games except the championship games will have one umpire. The championship games will have two umpires.
- A team not ready to play within 15 minutes of the scheduled start time of their game will forfeit that game. The exception being a team that is finishing up a previous game. • The higher seed each game will be designated the home team.
- The following run rules will apply:
 - 15 after 3 / 12 after 4 / 8 after 5.
 - Teams in the 10U Divisions may score a maximum of 5 runs per half inning, including championship games.
- Sunday games are 70 minutes, or 7 innings, or run-rule end, whichever comes first. No new inning may start after 70 minutes; innings in progress at the 70 minute mark will be completed.
- **Tie Breaker rules** on Sunday: If a game is tied after time has expired, there will be extra innings. Each extra inning will start with the following:
 - Inning 1 will start with the last batter out the previous inning on 2nd base and 0 outs.
 - Inning 2 will start with the last batter out the previous inning on 2nd base with 1 out
 - Inning 3 and beyond will start with the last batter out the previous inning on 2nd base with 2 outs until a winner has been determined.
