Tournament Rules

Play for Mother's Day

Fundraising Tournament to benefit Play for a Cure Oregon®

Complex Rules: Please share with your Parents.

- 🟡 **NO PETS ARE ALLOWED INSIDE THE COMPLEX.**
- 🟡 No bicycling, skateboarding, skating, large riding toys, and distracting or noise-making toys.
- 🟡 Smoking or vaping of any kind is prohibited in all City Parks, this includes the parking lot.
- 🟡 The use of alcoholic beverages is prohibited in City of Salem parks, streets, public open spaces, designated sports fields, and recreational buildings.
- 🟡 No glass bottles allowed inside the complex.
- 🟡 **The rain line number is 503-362-1396.**
- 🟡 **No hitting/bunting or pitching in the grass. EVER!**
- 🟡 **NO SUNFLOWER SEEDS, Shelled Nuts or Spitting OF ANY KIND.**
- 🟡 **ONE LARGE TEAM COOLER IS ALLOWED PER TEAM.**



Tournament Rules:

- 🟡 USA Softball Rules.
- 🟡 You may bat the roster.
- 🟡 Courtesy runners only for catcher and pitchers. If batting the roster, the last batter in the lineup that inning, if not it has to be a sub.
- 🟡 All games will have a time limit. No new inning after 1 hour and 20 minutes. Ties allowed in Pool Play. In the event of a tie during bracket play, the next inning will start with runners on 2nd & 3rd, and the modified tiebreaker will continue until there is a clear winner.
- 🟡 12U Bracket play will be seeded across the entire age group, not by pool. (Record/Head-to-Head/RA/RS).
- 🟡 Run Rules: 15 after 3 / 12 after 4 / 8 after 5 / 1 after 7
- 🟡 5 run rule (5 runs max per inning per team) will be in effect for any game a 10U team is playing in.

Linda L. Vladyka Breast Wellness Foundation:

- 🟡 The City of Salem typically hosts three softball tournaments to raise money for Play for a Cure Oregon®. In years past, benefits from these tournaments were one of the top sources of donations. To put into perspective the money raised last year during these tournaments helped about 115 high risk women to receive mammograms who would not otherwise of been able to get one. We were able to raise this money with the help of all the teams and families at the Play for a Cure Oregon® fundraising tournaments. With your help we hope to raise at least \$10,000 this year.
- 🟡 We are hoping each team can dig deep inside their pockets and donate at least \$100. That's less than \$10 per player. We will be giving away prizes for the team with the greatest donation. Please help us to reach our goal!
