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GENERAL INFORMATION SHEET

ACE Certification & Background Checks: At least one coach MUST be ACE certified.
All other Coaches & Team Moms that are on the field or in the dugouts MUST display proof of
Background Checks & SafeSports by wearing their Cards or Certificate.

1. There will be two (2) Pool Games and then a Double Elimination Tournament with all play governed by the 2026 USA Softball and USA Softball of Texas Official Rules.
2. All teams must be prepared to play by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, June 12, 2026.
3. Posted game time is forfeit time.
4. Both Pool Games will be 60 Minutes, finish the batter.
All Bracket Games, except the Championship and "IF" Games, will be 80 Minutes or 7 Innings, whichever occurs first. No new Inning will begin after 80 minutes. At the end of time or innings if a game is tied, the ITB will be used until a winner is determined.
The Championship and "IF" Games will be seven (7) innings, unless Run Rule applies.
5. USA Softball of Texas - District 39 will furnish the game balls.
6. Protests must be according to USA Softball Rules for 2026. The protest committee will render a ruling before play resumes.
7. No infield practice will be allowed at any time on the game fields.
8. Home team will be decided by flip of coin.
9. Team at the top of the bracket will take the 3rd base dugout; the team at the bottom of each bracket will take the first base dugout, exception: back-to-back games.
10. A suspended game will be resumed from the point of suspension.
11. Identification: All players proof of age.
12. Alcohol is not permitted anywhere in the complex.
13. Full concessions will be available at all fields. **Ice will be furnished for each player to fill her own drink container.** A team may bring in an ice chest containing ice and water for towels to be able to cool down players and coaches **and a 2nd cooler with drinks for players and coaches only.**
14. T-shirt vendor will be printing on-site. He will have Tournament T-shirts as well as other apparel.
15. The tournament director reserves the right to switch teams to a different field for the purpose of saving time if behind in the schedule or for any other circumstances that might arise.
